SA may recall Egypt ambassador - report

Cape Town - International Relations Minister Maite Nkoana-Mashabane has said South Africa may recall its ambassador to Egypt because it views the overthrow of former president Mohammed Morsi as a coup.

The Sunday Times reported Nkoana-Mashabane as saying: "If it means recalling our ambassador, we will do that. But if we think she should remain there observing what's going on in order to help fast-track returning Egypt to democratic and constitutional normalcy, we will do that."

"Our position was ... that which took place in Egypt is a military coup," she said.
